# **Index**

ArkivDigital offers access to several digital searchable-name indexes, which total more than 270 million index posts. The largest of them, BiS (Population of Sweden) 1800-1947, includes 171 million posts and is Sweden's largest name index.

In addition to personal indexes, we also offer some quick-find tools. Based on the year and parish name, these tools make it possible to quickly find the right page in the tax records, general muster rolls, and Statistics Sweden (SCB) birth, marriage, and death extracts.

# BiS (Population of Sweden) 1800-1947

The population of Sweden 1800-1947 is a digital, searchable name index to Sweden's household and congregation records from 1800 to 1947. The index contains approximately 165.8 million entries. In other words, it is a fantastic tool for solving the riddles in the family tree!

Where did the missing brother go? He is recorded in a household record in the 1840s but disappears without a trace. Indeed, he is moving somewhere. But where? The Population of Sweden 1800-1947 is the place to begin searching. Enter your information (often with names and birth dates) and get a search results list. Choose a match that looks interesting, and you get more information.

Still interesting? Click on the link, and the church book page where he is included will be displayed! Complex genealogy problems can be solved in minutes!

The index was created in partnership with MyHeritage.

In Stockholm City, no household or congregation books were created after 1877. From 1878 to 1926, another population registration system called the Roteman Institute existed. Instead of household and congregation books, special booklets (*mantalshäfte*) were created in which the population was recorded. The City of Stockholm Archives indexed these special booklets, which has provided ArkivDigital with the index. We have included them as part of the population in Sweden 1800-1947. NOTE! The Population of Sweden 1800- 1947 does not include information about the population of Stockholm from 1927 to 1947.

## Census of Sweden 1940

The index covers Sweden's population on December 31, 1940. The number of searchable persons totals 6.33 million. The source material for the index consists of the extracts sent from each parish to Statistics Sweden to form the basis for the 1940 census.

The index includes the following information:

First and last name Birthdate and birthplace (parish/county/country) Marital status

Residence (property/village/quarter, parish, in certain cases part of parish, county)

In addition, persons residing in the same household as the selected person are shown. There is also a link to the image from each index record from which the information has been indexed. Often, more information is in the original document.



# Census of Stockholm 1945

The register covers Stockholm's population as of December 31, 1945. The total number of searchable persons is 671,970. The index contains similar information to the Census of Sweden 1940.

# Census of Sweden 1950

The Census of Sweden 1950 is a powerful tool for anyone looking for their relatives in the 1900s. It is an index based on the 1951 tax register, established at the end of 1950, and includes every person who lived in Sweden then.

The 1950 Census includes the individual's complete name, address, birth date, birthplace, occupation, and marital status. The index record shows all the household members, but it does not say precisely how they are related to each other. However, if a man and woman live at the same address and have the same marriage date, they are most likely married. Additional information includes where someone was registered in earlier census records and a married woman's maiden name. You will also find a link to the birth book where the person's birth record is located.

# **Census of Sweden1960**

The index includes information similar to the information from the Census of Sweden in 1950 but for 1960.

# Census of Sweden 1970

The Census of Sweden 1970 contains more than 8 million searchable records about the people who lived in Sweden in 1970. You can find information about name, date of birth and place, marital status, title/occupation, address, nationality, and people living in the same household.

The source of Sweden's population in 1970 is data extracted from the 1971 tax register and refers to the conditions on November 1, 1970. The data differs from the older tax records, the basis for Sweden's population in 1950 and 1960. The tax registers were not yet computerized but printed on paper. For Västmanland, the tax register for 1971 is missing, and therefore, we have included data from the 1972 tax register, which refers to the conditions on 1 November 1971 for Västmanland.

## Census of Sweden 1975

The index contains just over 8.2 million entries, and if you search, you will find the same type of information as in the Census of Sweden 1970.

The source for the Census of Sweden 1975 is data extracted from the 1976 tax register.

# Census of Sweden 1980

The Census of Sweden 1980 contains 8.3 million searchable records about the people who lived in Sweden in 1980. You can find information about name, date of birth and place, marital status, address, nationality, and people living in the same household.

The Census of Sweden 1980 is based on data extracted from the 1981 tax register and refers to the conditions on November 1, 1980. Göteborg and Bohuslän do not have a tax register for 1981, so we report data from the 1982 tax register regarding the conditions on November 1, 1981, for Gothenburg and Bohuslän.



# Census of Sweden 1985

The Census of Sweden 1985 is a data extract from the 1986 tax register reflecting November 1, 1985 conditions. For Uppsala County, the tax register for 1986 is missing. Instead, the source for Uppsala County is the 1987 tax register reflecting conditions on November 1, 1986.

The 1985 Census of Sweden includes the same data as the 1980 Census (see above).

# Census of Sweden 1990

The Census of Sweden 1990 contains just over 8.5 million searchable entries about the people who lived in Sweden in 1990. You will find information about name, date of birth and place, marital status, address, nationality, and people living in the same household.

The Census of Sweden1990 is based on a data extract from the 1991 tax register and refers to the conditions on November 1, 1990.

# Swedes in US 1940

The database is an extract from the 1940 US Census. The census was taken on 1 April 1940, and the extract contains the persons stated to have been born in Sweden (approximately 447,000 persons). In addition to information about name, age, and marital status, there is information about where the person lived in 1940 and April 1, 1935.

# **Emigrants**

The Emigrants index is based on lists of emigrants drawn up by the local police authorities in Stockholm, Gothenburg, Malmö, and Helsingborg. The years included vary from city to city, but most records come from the latter part of the 1800s and the beginning of the 20th century. In total, almost 1.5 million entries are included in the register. The index was created in collaboration with Ancestry.

# Birth, Marriage, and Death Indexes

Name index to birth, marriage, and death books from the earliest times (the 1600s) to the second half of the 19th century, sometimes even later.

All births and marriages in Sweden have been indexed from 1750 to 1840, along with deaths for all of Sweden from 1750 to 1799. Marriages are indexed from the earliest times to 1860 for all of Gotland county.

# **Estate inventories**

The estate inventories index is a name-searchable index for estate inventories from district and city courts. The index is under construction and currently comprises 6.5 million searchable entries from all over Sweden for different time periods. More searchable material will come later. # **Portrait Collection**

A searchable name index of personal portraits from three Stockholm studios, Jaeger, Bergne, and Welinder. A quarter of a million pictures are included, photographed from the 1920s to the 1970s. Most of the portraits refer to Stockholmers, but there are also photographs from other parts of the country.

# **Prisoner Portrait**

This index contains, among other things, those released from prisons throughout Sweden between 1876 and 1910. It also includes additional photographs from various prisons and time periods.

# **Move Certificates**

The name-searchable index of moving certificates for Gotland has 31,425 records. You can search by your relative's name to quickly find out if there is a move certificate.

# **Military Service Cards**

The index includes military service cards (also called *stamkort*) for enlisted men (who were enrolled) between 1902 and 1950. The enlistment age was changed in 1914 from 21 to 20, meaning the register includes men born between 1881 and 1930.

Conscription cards contain the conscript's name and information about birth date and place of birth. Additional information on the card is the branch of service the recruit served in, service time (basic and additional military training and any emergency preparation service during World War II), promotions, and punishment records. Even occasionally, the conscript's home address and civil occupation are recorded.

The index comprises approximately 2.4 million entries/conscription cards. Finding your way through the cards without the help of the index is difficult, as they are divided among many different archive creators who have sorted the cards in many different ways.



# **Agriculture Statistics 1944**

In 1944, Statistiska Centralbyrån (Statistics Sweden) conducted a nationwide agricultural census and sent forms to farms. Each farm owner or user filled in information about the size of the property, types of tools and machines used on the farm, the presence of water pipes, sewers, electricity, and additional information. The Agricultural Census comprises a total of approximately 440,000 farms. The following information is registered and searchable in the register:

Owner's name
User's name
County
Place (parish, municipality, town, city)
Household name
Apartment, torp, urban area

# **Boatswain active list**

At the end of the 19th century, the so-called boatmen's rolls were kept for a few decades. Each boatman was given his own little book, in which you can follow his career from admission to dismissal. Among other things, we learn what the boatswain looked like, when, where, and how he served, and whether he had been punished at any time. The index, which covers more than 4600 boatmen born between 1816 and 1877, makes it easy to find the roll for each boatman.

# **Employees at Papyrus**

Employee name index for the paper mill AB Papyrus in Mölndal from the beginning of the 1910s to the 1950s. The index comprises just over 9,200 indexed entries.

# Riddarhuset, collection of portraits

This index is searchable at the family name/family level to Riddarhuset's portrait collection. The collection contains about 13,000 photographs of noble people from the 19th and 20th centuries.

# **Land registrations Northern Gotland**

Index to land registration protocols and Northern Gotland's Northern District Archive documents. About 35,000 posts from 1800-1870 are included in the index—searchable information for parish, property, and year.

# **Quick Find: SCB extracts**

Table of Contents on the year and parish level to the Statistiska Centralbyråns (SCB) extracts of birth-, marriage- and death books from 1925-1947 (1930-1947 for parishes in Stockholm city). Enter the desired record type, year, and parish, and get a direct link to the page where the record begins.



# **Quick Find: Mantals Tax Records**

Our table of contents for Mantals tax records makes finding the tax registers (mantalslängder) for a particular parish or city for a specific year easy. With a few simple keystrokes, you can quickly find the right page in any of the approximately 9400 volumes in the Quick find: Mantals tax records database.

In cases where the tax records are missing, 1719-1765. the salary and fee payment (*betalningsavgiften*) records can function as a replacement source. These records, included in the Riksgäldens archive, are also in the table of contents.

# **Quick Find: General Muster Rolls**

The quick find – general muster rolls index includes the general muster rolls for the allotment (*indelta*) regiments within the borders of current Sweden from when the musters were conducted in the 1680s until they ceased being undertaken in the 1880s. The information included in the index records consists of the regiment name, year, and company name/other page content.

# **Archive documents**

ArkivDigital is an online service that provides access to newly photographed images of Swedish historical records.

ArkivDigital has currently (October 2024) digitized approximately 100 million images.

In the church books, you will find the basics about your ancestors needed for your research and information about names and dates of birth. But it is when you start reading and researching other types of materials, the ancestors come to life, and you "get to know them." In ArkivDigital's online archive, therefore, in addition to the church books, there is also a large selection of other types of documents: estate inventories, court records, tax records, prison rolls, military documents of various kinds, and aerial photographs of farms and other buildings are just a few examples of what is available.

In addition, you can view nearly 4.7 million aerial photos of photos and buildings around Sweden from the 1950s to the current.






